PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Robert Y. Bowman, Deputy Mayor for Economic Development for the City of Akron, was our primary speaker at the May 4th General Lunch Meeting. Samuel D. DeShazor, Deputy Planning Director was also present and filled in as did Richard A. Merolla, Director of Public Service.

Mr. Bowman discussed transitioning Akron to the Global Economy. One industrial job (new product production etc.) creates 2½ non-basic (service) jobs. The challenge, then, is to transition to a technology manufacturing base with innovative new products using our strength. The City has an innovative strategy which it calls the Bridge Strategy. The City is using the Akron Global Business Accelerator to attract business in other countries. So far the City is working with businesses in Chemnitz, Germany; Netanya, Israel; China and Finland.

What has been and is being done in the Kenmore Community was also discussed. Our general meetings have been excellent and have been well attended.

Some of us attended the Thanksgiving in May gathering at Open M on Friday May 6th, which was sponsored by South Akron Board of Trade.
